**Supplies will be labeled and managed in the classroom. Do NOT put names on anything except the beach towel.



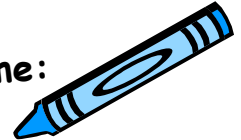
Back to School Supplies TC Miller School for Innovation Grade 1

- 1 Spelling Dictionary - this can be purchased on Registration Day for \$3.00.

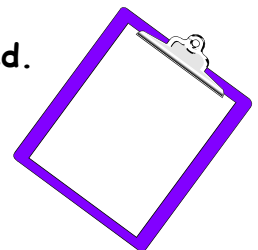

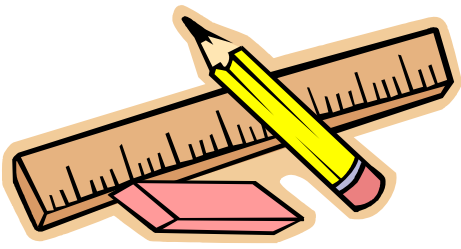


SECOND GRADE SUPPLY LIST
